FIRST ANNOUNCEMENT AND CALL FOR PAPERS

Society for Electronics, Telecommunications, Computers, Automatic Control and Nuclear Engineering (ETRAN) is the largest and the most prestigious Serbian professional society that gathers engineers and researchers from industry, universities and R&D institutes. The society cherishes tradition of organizing annual conferences since 1955 aiming to gather researchers from diverse areas of electrical and electronic engineering and to support cross-pollination of ideas.

The national and international conferences run in parallel and typically feature invited key lectures, tutorials, roundtables, specialized sessions and workshops related to the electrical engineering.

The conference is organized with the support of IEEE.

SCOPE

IcETRAN comprises 17 sections that cover the following areas:

- 17. Education in Electrical, Electronic and Computing Engineering.

The official language at IcETRAN is English.

Up to six-page long regular manuscripts prepared in the standard double column format (http://etran.etf.rs/etran2016/fajlovi/ETRAN.word.eng.doc) are invited. Submitted papers should present original results of theoretical or practical research applied to practical engineering problems. Papers submitted for presentation at the IcETRAN Conference will be peer-reviewed.

Selected papers will be invited for possible publication in Serbian Journals in particular disciplines. Best paper and best student paper will be chosen in each of the sections, and the first author will receive the certificate and free participation at the IcETRAN 2018 or ETRAN 2018.

VENUE



Meetings will take place in the hotel "Đerdap" in Kladovo, Serbia.

The city of Kladovo is 255 km far from Belgrade.

Kladovo is in the vicinity of the Hydro Power Plant "Đerdap" and across of Turnu Severin, Romania.



Kladovo is also close to the point where Danube achieves the maximum depth and changes from the minimum to the maximum width. Therefore it is called the Iron Gate. The Danube riverside has many traces of the Roman ("*Tabula Traiana*", "*Traians Bridge*") and Turks presence (the fortress "*Fetislam*" built at the time of the Suleiman the Magnificent). A boat trip will be organized which includes short visits to the points of interest along the river Danube.

CONFERENCE FEES AND REGISTRATION

Conference fees will be announced on the website of the ETRAN society http://etran.etf.rs/index_e.html.

One registration fee is valid for one accepted paper. Only papers presented at the Conference by a registered participant will be published in the Proceedings.

Members of the ETRAN Society and the IEEE pay only 80% of the regular fees.

Young authors, members of the ETRAN Society, being the first author of an IcETRAN paper presented at the Conference is entitled to stay for two nights (breakfast included) for free during the conference and pays only 50% of the registration fee. The Young author status is defined with: 1) bachelor degree student: born after June 5, 1992; 2) master degree student: born after June 5, 1990; 3) doctoral student: born after June 5, 1987; and 4) a researcher with a Ph.D. degree received after June 5, 2011, and born after June 5, 1981
